### About this topic

This topic is one of the specialized topic in 'Aviation safety & security workshop – for aviation logistics beginners'. It is designed to provide participants to have understanding in daily export shipment; focused on dangerous goods including how to identify the hidden hazard, handling skills of dangerous goods in loading and storage and the emergency response procedures in accident /incident relates to dangerous goods.
